UPKEEP AND LUBRICATION OF THE CUTTING BLADE

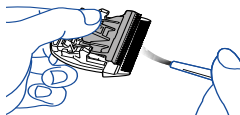

Depending on the model, I place the
dial on **2 mm**, or **1.5 mm** for
the Fading ER-GP86, to remove
the cutting blade.

I remove the small hairs with
the Panasonic brush provided.



3

Then I lubricate using
the Panasonic Oil or **the Fresh
Oiler Maintenance Spray**, the only
formula recommended by Panasonic
for use on its clippers.

If necessary, for a refrigerant
action, I spray longer without
removing the cutting blade.



*When the clipper is new, you must lubricate the cutting blade
before its first use.

When the clippers are new, you must allow for **AN INITIAL CHARGING TIME** to optimize the performance of your batteries.

CHARGE INDICATORS

At the initial charging, please wait for 2 or 3 minutes before red light appears.



When the battery level light blinks **green** or **white**, it's time to recharge your clipper.

The clipper can be used for 5 more minutes after this light flashes.



During the recharging, the light is **solid red**.



It **flashes red** or **light off** when the charge is **complete**
